## ***Information for Getting Around***

<b>Buses</b>	<p>Yellow school buses will meet guests at the train station at 9:18, 10:16 and 11:16. From 11:00 – 5:00 buses will circulate to all venues.</p> <p><b>Longshore (pool, tennis):</b> The bus stops in front of the Tennis Pavilion building. The next stop is the <b>Beach:</b> The bus stops to the left of the beach entrance, in front of the children’s playground and volleyball court.</p> <p><b>Downtown:</b> The bus stops in front of the library on the river side. Note that after the Historical Society Downtown Tour, a special bus will meet our guests at the Westport Arts Center.</p> <p><b>Earthplace:</b> The bus stops at the Main Entrance. There will be a dedicated bus for the morning tour. Afterwards buses will visit periodically.</p> <p><b>Wakeman Town Farm:</b> A dedicated bus will leave Saugatuck after lunch at 2:00 to go to Wakeman Town Farm for the tour. Afterwards the bus will bring our guests directly to Compo Beach and Longshore and then Saugatuck.</p>
<b>Car</b>	<p>Your welcome packet contains a map of Westport and a parking pass. Please display the pass on your dashboard. Parking at Longshore and Compo Beach is normally restricted, but our United Nations guests have special access today.</p>
<b>Trains</b>	<p>Trains depart Grand Central at 8:02 (arrives Westport 9:18), 9:02 (arrives 10:16), and 10:02 (arrives 11:16).</p> <p>For the return trip, trains depart Westport at 2:08, 2:32, 3:08, 3:32, 4:08, 4:32, 5:08, 5:32, 6:08 and 6:32. (Note: the last bus will circle all venues at 5:00.)</p>
<b>Taxis</b>	<p>If you choose to stay in Westport past the last bus pickup, the Saugatuck Taxi Service’s number is (203) 571-1111. Alternatively, the Westport Star Taxi Service’s telephone number is (203) 227-5157. The cost from the beach to the train station is approximately \$10.00. UBER is also available in Westport.</p>
<b><i>About Our FREE Tours</i></b>	
<b>Earthplace</b>	<p>There is a guided tour of Earthplace at 11:30. The Earthplace bus will leave immediately after the ceremony and pick up guests to return for lunch. Buses will pick up and drop off at Earthplace throughout the day.</p>
<b>Downtown Westport History Tour</b>	<p>The Westport Historical society is offering a free guided tour of the Society and Downtown Westport, across the Ruth Steinkraus-Cohen Bridge (flying all the flags of the United Nations) to the Westport Arts Center at 11:30. The Downtown History Tour will leave immediately after the ceremony. The same bus will pick up guests at the Westport Arts Center at 51 Riverside Ave (.3 mile from Saugatuck Elementary). If you chose to walk back to Saugatuck Elementary School, turn left on Riverside Ave from the Arts Center and take a lovely walk along the river.</p>
<b>Wakeman Town Farm</b>	<p>Wakeman Town Farm is Westport’s newest initiative: a model farm demonstrating sustainable farming practices. The Farm will provide a tour for those interested in local food production, energy conservation, and responsible land stewardship.</p>

<p><b>Saugatuck Elementary School</b>  <b>170 Riverside Ave</b>  <b>Westport CT 06880</b></p>	<p>jUNe Day on the Saugatuck River! This state-of-the-art elementary school is air-conditioned and will be the site of a continental breakfast and our welcoming ceremony. The soccer fields and the two children’s playgrounds are here. A buffet lunch will be served here from 12:30 – 2:30.</p>
<p><b>Longshore Pool and Tennis</b>  <b>260 South Compo Road</b>  <b>Westport CT 06880</b></p>	<p>Outdoor pools located on Long Island Sound. The tennis courts are located here. There are changing rooms. Enjoy shady places to sit and enjoy the day at the kids’ playgrounds. There is a snack bar where you can buy food. Your registration packet contains a free ice cream coupon for the snack bar.</p>
<p><b>Longshore Golf Club</b>  <b>260 South Compo Road</b>  <b>Westport CT 06880</b></p>	<p>Westport’s municipal golf course by Long Island Sound. The UN Golf Club has worked with the International Hospitality Committee to set up today’s tee’s times. It is too late to register for today’s event, but contact the UN Golf Club for next year.</p>
<p><b>Compo Beach</b>  <b>64 Compo Beach Road</b>  <b>Westport, CT 06880</b></p>	<p>Westport’s beach and brand-new children’s playground. The beach has lifeguards and is excellent for swimming and walking. There is a changing room and showers. Your welcome packet includes a free ice cream coupon at the full-service snackbar, Joey’s Place.</p>
<p><b>Earthplace</b>  <b>10 Woodside Lane</b>  <b>Westport Ct 06880</b></p>	<p>Fomerly the Nature Center, Earthplace offers nature exhibits and pleasant woodland and meadow walks. There will be two guided walking tours of their wildlife rescue program, exhibits and nature trails.</p>
<p><b>Westport Historical Society</b>  <b>25 Avery Place, Westport CT</b></p> <p><b>Downtown Westport/</b></p> <p><b>Westport Arts Center</b>  <b>51 Riverside Avenue, Westport CT</b></p>	<p>The Westport Historical Society offers a glimpse of historic Westport. Visit the gift shop for unique local gifts. Westport’s downtown offers fine shopping in a relaxed atmosphere. Cross the Ruth Steinkraus-Cohen Bridge with the UN Member Flags flying for jUNe Day on your way to the Westport Arts Center for an exhibit of local artists’ work in their gallery along the Saugatuck River after the Downtown History tour</p>
<p><b>Wakeman Town Farm</b>  <b>134 Cross Highway</b>  <b>Westport CT 06880</b></p>	<p>Wakeman Town Farm is a model of sustainable and organic farming practices. Its goal is to provide hands on guidance for those interested in local food production, energy conservation, and responsible land stewardship. If you are driving – the farm looks like a white house on the corner. If you see Christies Market, you have gone too far.</p>
